- ___ **Telling the truth.** *Being honest with your words.*
- ___ **Keeping your word.** *Doing what you said you would do.*
- ___ **Showing up on time.** *To meetings, work, appointments.*
- ___ **Managing your money.** *Paying your bills, spending responsibly, living within your means.*
- ___ **Doing your job.** *Giving your boss or your clients an honest day's labor for an honest day's pay.*
- ___ **Sharing credit.** *At work, at home, giving people proper credit for what they do.*
- ___ **Internet Browser History.** *Which web sites are you looking at?*
- ___ **Conversation.** *Talking to others, talking about others, your vocabulary.*
- ___ **Giving.** *This includes tithing and sharing your abundance with others.*
- ___ **Helping others.** *Being willing to inconvenience yourself in order to do something good for someone else.*
- ___ **Managing your emotions.** *Anger, self-pity, pride, bitterness, arrogance, patience.*
- ___ **Respect.** *Treat people with dignity, regardless of color or position or economic status.*
- ___ **Prayer life.** *If you are a Christian, is prayer a foundational part of your life?*
- ___ **Bible study.** *Are you spending time in the Word each day?*
- ___ **Worship.** *I'm not just talking about church attendance, I'm talking about private devotional worship, where everyday you surrender to and celebrate the Lordship of Jesus Christ.*
